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Hoss's Steak and Sea House Raises Over \$3,000 to Support MDA Families Living with Neuromuscular Disease

35 local locations raised vital funds for MDA families through a flat iron steak meal deal program

PITTSBURGH, PA, October 25th, 2017 — Thirty-five Hoss's Steak and Sea House restaurants raised more than \$3,000 during their annual flat iron steak meal deal program. This program benefitted the Muscular Dystrophy Association to help save and improve the lives of kids and adults fighting muscular dystrophy, ALS and related life-threatening diseases that severely limit muscle strength and mobility.

From September 5th to October 1st, customers and employees helped accelerate progress for people whose abilities to move are compromised — including everyday abilities like walking, running, hugging, talking and even breathing — by ordering the flat iron meal, Hoss's gave customers a free Pepsi glass and donated a dollar from every flat iron meal sold.

Funds also help send local children affected by
